Coming Up This Autumn and Winter

As the summer sun sets and the days grow shorter, our parish life continues to be a source of warmth and light. We have a wonderful lineup of events and services planned for the autumn and winter months, and we invite everyone in our community to join us. Whether you're a long-time member or a newcomer, there's something for everyone.

We're kicking things off with a lively afternoon of **Hymns with Pimm's** on **September 21 at 3pm**. Come sing your favourite hymns and enjoy a refreshing drink—it's the perfect way to spend a Sunday afternoon; our last look back to Summer.

Early in October, Harvest Festival service at 10 am and we will hold our annual Pet service on October 5 at 3pm. Bring your beloved companions, from dogs and cats to hamsters and rabbits, for a special blessing.

Later in the month, we will be holding a **Taizé service** on **October 26** at **4pm**. This reflective service features simple, repetitive chants and silent meditation, creating a peaceful and contemplative atmosphere. **We'll have another Taizé service on November 23 at 4pm**.

The festive season begins in late November with two beautiful services. On **November 29 at 3pm**, our much-loved **Christingle service** returns. This is a wonderful family event that helps children understand the story of Jesus as the light of the world. Then, on **November 30 at 6pm**, we'll have our **Advent Service of Light**, a special evening celebrating the promise of the coming into the world of the light of Christ.

As we move into December, the calendar is filled with opportunities to celebrate the birth of Jesus. We'll have our **Community Carols** on **December 14 at 3pm**, followed by our main **Carol service** on **December 21 at 4pm**, where we will sing traditional Christmas carols by candlelight.

Christmas Eve is packed with services for all ages. Our **Crib service** at **3pm** is perfect for families with young children, telling the nativity story in a simple and engaging way. Later that night, we'll have our beautiful **Midnight Mass starting at 11.30pm**, a traditional and solemn service to welcome Christmas Day.

We'll start the new year with a moment of reflection and hope with our **Prayers for the year** on **January 1 at 3pm**.

The charities were: Friends of St Michael's, Breast Cancer Now, HomeStart, Alexander Devine, The Children's Society and Alzheimers Dementia Support 'ADS' Maidenhead branch. Along the way the Devine Buskers entertained us.

The braver of you were able to take a trip up the bell tower with the Bellringers, and St Michael's Vintage joined us for two of the teas. I hope a good time was had at all the teas by everyone involved.

Sarah Pawluk took her donation to Homestart.
